

3. Regen Lab hereby seeks (1) injunctive relief against Defendant's continued unauthorized, improper and willful commercial use and exploitation of any trademark confusingly similar to any of Regen Lab's trademarks; and (2) all damages arising from Defendant's past and present infringement, including all statutory damages, and Regen Lab's attorneys' fees and costs for having to bring this suit to enforce its trademark rights.

PARTIES

4. Plaintiff Regen Lab, is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Switzerland and having a place of business at En Budron B2, 1052 Le Mont-sur-Lausanne, Switzerland.

5. Regen Lab is known throughout the world as a provider of medical and laboratory and pharmaceutical products, which are distributed under the globally famous REGENLAB brand. REGENLAB and the products sold under this brand are known worldwide to be synonymous with superior quality.

6. In the U.S., Regen Lab is represented by RegenLab USA LLC, a Delaware corporation having a place of business at 575 Madison Avenue, New York, NY 10022-2511.

7. Upon information and belief, Defendant is a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Maryland having a place of business at 5107 Pegasus Ct., Suite L, Frederick, MD 21704.

8. Upon information and belief, Defendant is a distributor and seller of medical and laboratory and pharmaceutical equipment.

9. Upon information and belief, Defendant is doing business through the website www.regenlabequip.com.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

10. This Court has jurisdiction pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1121, 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331, and 1338(a) and (b) over the federal trademark infringement and related claims, which arise under the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1051 *et seq.* This Court also has diversity jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 1332 because Regen Lab and Defendant are citizens of different states and the amount in controversy exceeds \$75,000.00, exclusive of interest and costs. This Court has supplemental jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1338(b) and 1367 over the state law claims.

11. Defendant has been doing business in this District, and has and is advertising, distributing, offering for sale, and selling products wrongfully bearing infringements of Regen Lab's trademark to persons located within this District.

12. This Court has personal jurisdiction over Defendant because, *inter alia*, Defendant (1) transacts business within this District, (2) contracts to supply goods or services in this District, (3) has committed a tortious act within this District, (4) has committed a tortious act causing injury to Regen Lab within this District, (5) regularly does or solicits business, or engages in other persistent course of conduct, or derives substantial revenue from goods used or consumed or services rendered, in this District, (6) expects or should reasonably expect the act to have consequences in this District and derives substantial revenue from interstate or international commerce, (7) has systematic and continuous contacts with this District, (8) continues to transact and do business in this District, and (9) has websites and social media accounts that are accessible in this District.

13. Venue is proper in this judicial district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1391(b) and (c) because a substantial part of the wrongful events giving rise to this action took place in this District and Regen Lab has suffered harm in this District.

FACTS COMMON TO ALL CLAIMS FOR RELIEF

Regen Lab's Famous Trademark

14. Regen Lab has been continuously conducting business in the medical and laboratory and pharmaceutical industries since at least as early as 2003.
15. Regen Lab conducts business, markets, promotes, offers for sale and sells its Products in the U.S. through its fully-owned U.S. subsidiary RegenLab USA LLC.
16. Regen Lab owns and conducts business using the website www.regenlab.com, as well as through a physical sales force.
17. Regen Lab's U.S. consumers include physicians and physician offices.
18. Regen Lab is the owner of the U.S. Trademark Registration for "REGENLAB," Reg. No. 3922275, which registered on February 22, 2011("the Mark"). *See Exhibit A*, a true and correct copy of the REGENLAB trademark registration.
19. The Mark is valid and subsisting and has become incontestable according to 15 U.S.C. § 1065.
20. The Mark is registered in class 05 for "Pharmaceutical and veterinary preparations, namely, solutions for application on and under tissue, bone and organ for the purpose of promoting cellular regeneration, tissue adhesion, wound healing, bone or periodontum growth and bone, organ or tissue regeneration; sanitary preparations for medical purposes; adjuvants for medical purposes; pharmaceutical skin lotions; tissues impregnated with pharmaceutical lotions for the treatment of damaged skin and tissue; medical dressings; surgical tissues; medicated skin care preparations; pharmaceutical preparations and substances for the treatment of damaged skin and tissue; products and preparations for medical purposes for cleaning the skin; Allograft tissue reconstitution solution kits; cells for medical or clinical

purposes; disinfectants for sanitary purposes; disinfectants for hygiene purposes; human, plant and animal cells and human, plant and animal tissues for use as anti-aging agent or skin repairing agent such as a scar repairing agent, lipoatrophy repairing agent, a wrinkle filling and repairing agent, for esthetic preparation, aging management, volume corrector and hair stimulator” and in class 10 for “Surgical apparatus and instruments for medical, dental or veterinary use; surgical and medical apparatus and instruments for use in dentistry, orthopedics, cosmetics, esthetics, general surgery, ophthalmology and mesotherapy; surgical and medical apparatus and instruments for use in cardiovascular, esthetic, cardiac, thoracic, transplantation, head and neck, oral, bone, cartilage, tendon, implant, gastrointestinal, orthopedic, neurosurgical, facial, face-lift and plastic surgery; suture materials; irrigators for injections; cases fitted for medical instruments; syringes for medical purposes; cases fitted for use by surgeons and doctors; injection instruments without needles; injection instruments with needles; surgical instruments for identifying, separating or ablating biological tissues; medical and surgical apparatus and instruments for use in general surgery; medical apparatus for taking blood; medical apparatus for taking blood samples; blood component separation apparatus for medical use; medical instruments for filtering blood and blood components; medical apparatus for introducing pharmaceutical preparations into the human body; medical instruments, namely, surgical instruments for biological tissues.”

21. Regen Lab is known throughout the world as a provider of various medical and laboratory and pharmaceutical products, including centrifuges and those goods found in Reg. No. 3922275 (“the Products”), which are distributed under the Mark.

22. Regen Lab has been extensively and continuously using the Mark in U.S. commerce on the Products since at least as early as 2011.

23. Regen Lab is responsible for maintaining control over the quality of the Products in the U.S.

24. Regen Lab has expended substantial sums and resources on marketing and publicity of the Mark throughout the U.S.

25. Regen Lab has developed a reputation of high quality for the Products in the U.S.

26. The trade name REGEN LAB and the Mark have become a strong identifiers of the Products.

27. By virtue of the long use of the trade name REGEN LAB and the Mark, the high quality of the Products, and Regen Lab's substantial marketing and publicity of the Mark, the Mark is now famous and has been famous since long before the activities of the Defendant complained of herein.

Defendant's Infringing Activities

28. Upon information and belief, Defendant is a distributor and seller of medical and laboratory and pharmaceutical equipment.

29. Upon information and belief, Defendant recently changed its name to "Regen Lab Equipment" and began promoting use of the Mark, or a mark substantially similar thereto, in connection with its equipment. *See Exhibit B*, screenshots from Defendant's website regarding new name.

30. Upon information and belief, Defendant markets and distributes its equipment to physicians and physician offices.

31. Long after Regen Lab's adoption and first use of its trade name and the Mark, Defendant started to use Regen Lab's trade name and Mark, or a mark substantially similar thereto, as its own, without authorization from Regen Lab, in connection with medical and

laboratory and pharmaceutical equipment, including but not limited to centrifuges (the “Infringing Goods”). See **Exhibit C** screenshots from Defendant’s website promoting and offering for sale the Infringing Goods.

32. Upon information and belief, Defendant markets and sells the Infringing Goods through physical sales and its operation of an interactive website, available at www.regenlabequip.com. Defendant’s website is publically accessible to consumers in New York and those throughout the U.S. and fully contains the Mark. See **Exhibit D**, screenshots from Defendant’s website promoting activities in New York.

33. On June 9, 2016, Regen Lab, through its attorneys, sent Defendant a letter placing it on notice of Regen Lab’s federal rights and long term use of its trade name and the Mark, and demanding that Defendant cease use of the Mark, including but not limited to, doing business as “Regen Lab Equipment.”

34. In a letter from its attorneys dated June 27, 2016, Defendant refused to cease use of the Mark.

35. To date, Defendant continues to use Regen Lab’s trade name and Mark, or a mark substantially similar thereto, to conduct business and in connection with the Infringing Goods, without authorization from Regen Lab.

36. Defendant is not now, nor has it ever been associated, affiliated, or connected with or endorsed or sanctioned by Regen Lab, nor has it been authorized by Regen Lab to use the Mark.

37. Regen Lab is not able to monitor, enforce or maintain its quality control standards on the Infringing Goods that Defendant is offering for sale and selling.

38. Defendant’s use of Regen Lab’s trade name and Mark, or a mark substantially

similar thereto, in the manner described herein creates the wrongful impression that Defendant's goods originate from Regen Lab and/or that such goods are authorized, sponsored or approved by Regen Lab even though they are not. This confusion causes irreparable harm to Regen Lab and the Mark.

39. Defendant has been and/or will continue be unjustly enriched by the illegal use and misappropriation of the Mark, or a mark substantially similar thereto, for its own financial gain. Additionally, Defendant has unfairly benefited and profited from Regen Lab's outstanding reputation for high quality goods, as well as its significant advertising and promotion of its goods and the Mark.

40. Defendant's acts are willful and deliberate and therefore this case constitutes an exceptional case under 15 U.S.C. § 1117(a).

41. Upon information and belief, Defendant's acts will continue unless enjoined by this Court.

42. Regen lab has no adequate remedy at law.

COUNT I
Trademark Infringement Under 15 U.S.C. § 1114

43. Regen Lab repeats and re-alleges each and every allegation in the foregoing paragraphs as if fully set forth herein.

44. The Mark and the goodwill of the business associated therewith in the U.S. and throughout the world are of great and significant value, and are highly distinctive of the Products.

45. Defendant's actions described herein have caused and are likely to cause confusion and mistake and to deceive potential customers and the general purchasing public as to the source, origin, or sponsorship of Defendant's goods, and are likely to deceive the public into

believing that the goods offered and sold by Defendant originate from, are associated with, or are otherwise authorized by Regen Lab, all to the damage and detriment of Regen Lab's reputation, goodwill and sales.

46. Defendant's unauthorized use of the Mark constitutes trademark infringement, the full extent of which is presently unknown but is substantial. This has caused damage to Regen Lab and the substantial business and goodwill symbolized by the Mark in violation of Section 32 of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1114.

47. Defendant's actions described above, including the unauthorized use of the Mark in interstate commerce, have caused, and unless restrained will continue to cause, great and irreparable injury to Regen Lab, to the Mark, and to the business and goodwill represented thereby, leaving Regen Lab with no adequate remedy at law.

COUNT II

False Designation of Origin and Unfair Competition Under 15 U.S.C. § 1125

48. Regen Lab repeats and re-alleges each and every allegation in the foregoing paragraphs as if fully set forth herein.

49. This claim is against Defendant for trademark infringement in violation of Section 43(a) of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1125(a).

50. Upon information and belief, Defendant has used, is using, and intends to continue using now and in the future in commerce the Mark for the offer and provision of goods and services in such a way that has and/or will cause confusion, mistake, or deception as to the affiliation, connection, or association of Defendant with Regen Lab.

51. Upon information and belief, Defendant's use of the Mark for the offer and provision of goods and services has likely caused and/or will cause confusion of the relevant public and trade.

52. Regen Lab has been and/or will be damaged by the confusion, mistake, and deception caused by Defendant's use of the Mark.

53. Any defect, objection to, or fault found with Defendant's goods and/or services sold or provided under the Mark would necessarily reflect on and seriously injure the reputation Regen Lab has established for its trademarks and business.

54. Regen Lab does not and has never consented to or authorized Defendant's adoption or commercial use of the Mark for the aforementioned goods and/or services. Defendant therefore has infringed and is infringing the Mark in violation of Section 43(a) of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. §1125(a).

55. Upon information and belief, at all times relevant to this action, including when Defendant first adopted the Mark and commenced commercial use of the Mark on or in connection with the aforementioned goods, Defendant knew of the prior adoption and widespread commercial use of the Mark by Regen Lab, and Defendant knew of the valuable goodwill and reputation acquired by Regen Lab in connection with the Mark. Defendant's infringement of the Mark is therefore willful.

56. Upon information and belief, Defendant, even after being placed on notice of Regen Lab's rights through correspondence dated June 9, 2016, continues to use the Mark in commerce. Defendant's infringement of the Mark is therefore willful.

57. Upon information and belief, Defendant's use of the Mark has caused and/or will cause confusion and mistake and deception to purchasers as to the source or origin of Defendant's infringing goods. Because of this, Regen Lab's valuable goodwill developed at great expense and effort is being irreparably harmed and is at risk of further damage.

58. Defendant's infringement will continue unless enjoined by the Court.

COUNT III
Trademark Dilution Under 43(c) of the Lanham Act

59. Regen Lab repeats and re-alleges each and every allegation in the foregoing paragraphs as if fully set forth herein.

60. The Mark is famous and distinctive within the meaning of Section 43(c) of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1125(c), and has been famous and distinctive since long before Defendant began using the Mark, or a mark substantially similar thereto. Among other things: the Mark has been used continuously throughout the United States to promote many goods and services long before the complained-of activities of Defendant; the Mark has an extremely high degree of recognition among consumers; the Mark is the subject of a valid and subsisting registration under the Lanham Act on the Principal Register; and the Mark is considered incontestable.

61. Long after the Mark became famous, Defendant, without authorization from Regen Lab, used unauthorized reproductions, copies and colorable imitations of the Mark. Defendant's use of the Mark dilutes and/or is likely to dilute the distinctive quality of the Mark and to lessen its capacity to identify and distinguish Regen Lab's goods. Defendant's unlawful use of the Mark in connection with inferior, infringing goods is also likely to tarnish the Mark and cause blurring in the minds of consumers between Regen Lab and Defendant, thereby lessening the value of the Mark as a unique identifier of Regen Lab's products.

62. By the acts described above, Defendant has intentionally and willfully diluted, and/or is likely to dilute, the distinctive quality of the famous Mark in violation of Section 43(c) of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1125(c).

63. Defendant's wrongful acts will continue unless enjoined by this Court.

64. Defendant's acts have caused, and will continue to cause, irreparable injury to

Regen Lab. Regen Lab has no adequate remedy at law and is thus damaged in an amount not yet determined.

COUNT IV
Cybersquatting Under 15 U.S.C. § 1125(d)(1)

65. Regen Lab repeats and re-alleges each and every allegation in the foregoing paragraphs as if fully set forth herein.

66. Defendant's domain name www.regenlabequip.com is identical to, and/or confusingly similar to the Mark, which was distinctive and/or famous at the time that the Defendant registered this domain name.

67. The Defendant has registered and used the domain name www.regenlabequip.com with the bad-faith intent to profit from the Mark.

68. Defendant's activities as alleged herein violate the federal Anticybersquatting Consumer Protection Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1125(d)(1).

69. The Defendant had no bona fide noncommercial or fair use of the Mark.

70. The Defendant intended to divert consumers away from Regen Lab to the infringing domain name www.regenlabequip.com in a way that has harmed and/or will harm the goodwill represented by the Mark for commercial gain, and with the intent to tarnish and disparage the Mark by creating a likelihood of confusion as to the source, sponsorship, affiliation, or endorsement of the domain name www.regenlabequip.com.

71. Defendant's acts have caused, and will continue to cause, irreparable injury to Regen Lab. Regen Lab has no adequate remedy at law and is thus damaged in an amount not yet determined.

COUNT V

Deceptive Acts and Practices Under Section 349 of New York General Business Law

72. Regen Lab repeats and re-alleges each and every allegation in the foregoing paragraphs as if fully set forth herein.

73. Through the importation, distribution, advertisement, promotion, offering for sale and sale of products bearing the Mark, or a mark substantially similar thereto, Defendant has engaged in consumer-oriented conduct that has affected the public interest of New York and has resulted in injury to consumers in New York.

74. By the acts described above, Defendant has willfully engaged in deceptive acts or practices in the conduct of business and furnishing of goods in violation of Section 349 of the New York General Business Law.

75. Defendant's acts have caused, and will continue to cause, irreparable injury to Regen Lab. Regen Lab has no adequate remedy at law and is thus damaged in an amount not yet determined.

COUNT VI

Trademark Dilution and Likelihood of Injury to Business Reputation Under Section 360-1 of New York General Business Law

76. Regen Lab repeats and re-alleges each and every allegation in the foregoing paragraphs as if fully set forth herein.

77. Through prominent, long and continuous use in commerce, including commerce within New York, the Mark has become and continues to be famous and distinctive.

78. Long after the Mark became famous, Defendant, without authorization from Regen Lab, used unauthorized reproductions, copies and colorable imitations of the Mark. Defendant's use of the Mark dilutes and/or is likely to dilute the distinctive quality of the Mark and to lessen the capacity of the Mark to identify and distinguish Regen Lab's goods.

Defendant's unlawful use of the Mark in connection with inferior, infringing goods is also likely to tarnish the Mark and cause blurring in the minds of consumers between Regen Lab and Defendant, thereby lessening the value of the Mark as a unique identifier of Regen Lab's products.

79. By the acts described above, Defendant has diluted the distinctiveness of the Mark and caused a likelihood of harm to Regen Lab's business reputation in violation of Section 360-1 of the New York General Business Law.

80. Defendant's acts have caused, and will continue to cause, irreparable injury to Regen Lab. Regen Lab has no adequate remedy at law and is thus damaged in an amount not yet determined.

COUNT VII
Common Law Trademark Infringement

81. Regen Lab repeats and re-alleges each and every allegation in the foregoing paragraphs as if fully set forth herein.

82. Regen Lab's ownership and use of the Mark in the market for the Products predates the use by Defendant of the same mark, or a mark substantially similar thereto, in the same market.

83. Defendant's use in commerce of the Mark constitutes common law trademark infringement in that it is without Regen Lab's consent and is likely to cause consumer confusion as to source and origin.

84. Defendant's acts have caused, and will continue to cause, irreparable injury to Regen Lab. Regen Lab has no adequate remedy at law and is thus damaged in an amount not yet determined.

COUNT VIII
Unfair Competition Under Common Law

85. Regen Lab repeats and re-alleges each and every allegation in the foregoing paragraphs as if fully set forth herein.

86. By the acts described above, Defendant has intentionally engaged in unfair competition in violation of the common law of the State of New York.

87. Defendant's acts have caused, and will continue to cause, irreparable injury to Regen Lab. Regen Lab has no adequate remedy at law and is thus damaged in an amount not yet determined.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays for judgment as follows:

A. That judgment be entered in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant on each and every Claim in this Complaint;

B. For entry of an order and judgment requiring that Defendant and its officers, agents, servants, employees, owners, and representatives, and all other persons, firms, or corporations in active concert or participation with them, be enjoined during the pendency of this action and permanently thereafter from (a) using the Mark, or mark substantially and/or confusingly similar thereto; (b) doing any act or thing calculated or likely to cause confusion or mistake in the minds of the members of the public or prospective customers as to the source of the products offered or distributed by Defendant, or likely to confuse members of the public, or prospective customers, into believing that there is some connection between Plaintiff and Defendant or any other entity owned by or associated with Defendant; (c) otherwise infringing upon the Mark; (d) otherwise competing unfairly with Plaintiff in any manner; and (e) assisting,

aiding or abetting any other person or business entity in engaging in or performing any of the activities referred to in parts (a) through (d) of this paragraph;

C. For entry of an order and judgment directing Defendant, pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1116(a), to file with this Court and serve upon Plaintiff within thirty (30) days after entry of the injunction, a report in writing under oath setting forth in detail the manner and form in which Defendant has complied with the injunction and ceased all offering of products under the Mark as set forth above;

D. For a judgment in the amount of (a) three times Defendant's profits as a result of its wrongful conduct or (b) three times Plaintiff's damages, whichever is greater, pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1117 and other applicable law;

E. For entry of an order directing Defendant to transfer the domain name www.regenlabequip.com to Plaintiff;

F. Award Plaintiff the costs and disbursements of this action pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1117 and other applicable law and restitution and/or disgorgement of all revenues, earnings, profits, compensation, and benefits that may have been obtained by Defendant as a result of its unlawful and/or fraudulent business actions or practices;

G. Award Plaintiff its reasonable attorney's fees incurred herein as a result of Defendant's intentional and willful infringement, pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1117 and other applicable law;

H. Award Plaintiff such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper or otherwise provided by law.

JURY DEMAND

Plaintiff demands a trial by jury on all claims and issues so triable.

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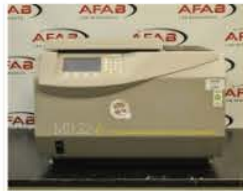
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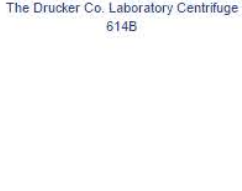
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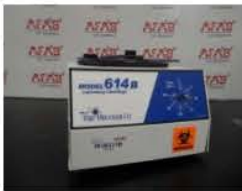
